## **FOOTBALL**

Training days will be finalized once we have a list of registered teams, traditionally Under 6 - 7's train one afternoon per week and have a match on Sunday Mornings.

Under 8's and over normally train one to two afternoons per week (at coaches discretion) plus a match on Sundays.

SAP – Skills acquisition programs are run though out the season for an additional fee.

Our Technical Director, Dr Fadi Ma'ayah along with the Junior, Senior and NPL coaching teams, follows the FFA Curriculum. Fadi ensures continuing professional development for all our coaches and that they carry the appropriate FFA accreditation.
