There are two ways to sign up:

1. **FAFC Junior Registration Day – Sunday the 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2018 from 9am -12pm** inside the Floreat Athena Clubrooms inside Litis Stadium. Come down and have a chat to coaches, managers and ask any questions you may have. There will be mini pitches set up on the field for the kids to run around and a free sausage sizzle.
2. **Register online** at <https://www.playfootball.com.au/player/player-registration>, then select Floreat Athena FC as your club and then proceed to choose your relevant age group or team. She will then advise when training commences and other important dates to keep in mind. Please register on time so we can ensure your club merchandise and soccer kit arrives prior to the season starting.

Training days will be finalized once we have a list of registered teams, traditionally U6-8's train one afternoon per week and have a match on Sunday Mornings.

U9's and over usually train 2 nights per week plus a match on Sunday.

There will also be numerous optional skills sessions (SAP – Skills acquisition program) - (at an extra fee) available during the season for extra training for those who wish to do so. Details will be released once available.

We follow the FFA curriculum and are excited to have our new Technical Director Dr Fadi Ma'ayah on board. Fadi will oversee all coaching at the club and ensure coaches are adequately up to date with current teachings and hold continuing professional development for our coaches. All our coaches will be accredited to the appropriate FFA levels in 2018.
