- Opportunities for promotion from Div 1 to NPL WA
- Lowest-ranked team/s from Div 1 may be relegated to Div 2

JUNIORS U13-U18

Junior Development League (JDL) U13-U16 | Mixed, Girls | Division 1-5

- Highest level of Junior Football in WA
- Enhanced player development in a structured league competition with promotion & relegation
- High level of commitment expected
- TD Camps
- Compete in JDL Cup
- Youth Club Championships (YCC) for U14 - U16 Team 1's
- Game time for individual players will vary
- Training twice weekly usually Wed and Fri

ACCREDITED COACHES

Junior Community League (JCL) U13-U18 | Mixed, Girls

- Local football competition for inclusivity, engagement and participation
- Compete in JCL Cup
- Equal game time is encouraged
- Training 1-2 times a week between Tues and Fri

VOLUNTEER COACHES

Games: Sundays, Cup Matches Saturdays, Occasional Midweek

Movement between phases at Miniros and Juniors can occur during the players development journey

ACADEMY Mixed

- Pathway to JDL
- Trials Required
- For players aspiring to the highest level
- Skills Acquisition Phase
- TD Camps
- Coaching Program supported by Technical Director
- Compete in Blue/Green/Orange Metro Divisions
- Training twice weekly usually Wed and Fri

DEVELOPMENT Mixed

- Stepping stone to academy with a focus on development
- Team selected from academy trials
- Skills Acquisition Phase
- Compete in Orange Metro or Purple Division (based on age & strength of group)
- Training 1-2 times per week between Tues and Fri

COMMUNITY Mixed

- Continue development without the higher commitment of Academy program
- All abilities
- Skills Acquisition Phase
- Focus on learning new skills, being active and making life-long friends
- Compete in Purple/Red/White/Yellow Divisions
- Training 1 or 2 times per week between Tues and Fri

GIRLS U10 & U12

- Compete in the Girls only league
- Soft grading - usually early to mid March
- Skills Acquisition Phase
- Teams can be placed in Blue (highest stream/all other divisions are based on location)
- Training 1 or 2 times per week between Tues and Fri
