U6s FAQs



| WHEN DO WE PLAY?

Training and matches will be both on Saturday mornings. Our U6s will commence their pre-match training session at 8.30am. Matches will commence at 9.00am and conclude at approximately 9.45am. Each U6s teams will play two 15-minute matches.

| WHERE DO WE PLAY?

All matches will be held at Britannia Reserve for the entire season.

| WHEN DOES THE SEASON COMMENCE?

The season will commence on Saturday, 20th April 2024 with a 2 week break over the winter school holidays. The last training/match of the season will be on Saturday, 31st August 2024.

| WHY ARE MATCHES BEING MOVED TO A SATURDAY?

Due to the huge growth we are experiencing at the club across all age groups it is necessary to move the U6s to a Saturday morning to ensure we have adequate space for all of our teams to play. We are a community club, and we endeavour to give all children that are interested in playing football the opportunity to play.

By moving our games to a Saturday morning, this will also mean that we will manage our own competition and not participate in the Football West Clusters competition. Every game will be played at home where there is plenty of parking available and closer to home for a lot of our families.

A benefit of moving the competition in-house and to a Saturday morning is that our coaches and in turn our players will benefit from having our Technical Director, Mark Jones oversee the program and assist and provide support to our coaches. Better coaches make better players!

| WHY HAS THE CLUB DECIDED NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FOOTBALL WEST CLUSTERS?

The Football West Clusters competition only runs on a Sunday morning. By moving our matches to a Saturday morning we are unable to participate in the Clusters competition.

Whilst we have participated in the Clusters competition in the past, as our numbers have grown it has become increasingly difficult for the other clubs we are placed with to accommodate the number of teams we submit. Last season, more often than not, our teams would be playing against our own teams due to the low team numbers submitted by the opposition clubs. This has also been a major factor in the decision to move to an in-house Saturday morning competition.

We will run our own inter-club clusters competition which will see children placed into 3 or 4 squads with a Head Coach appointed to each squad. Each squad will then be made up of smaller teams who will play against the other squad teams. In essence, very similar to the Football West Cluster competition.

| HOW MANY WILL BE IN A TEAM?

We will be playing a 4 a-side competition for the U6s. Depending on availability of children on a particular day there may be between 5 – 6 children in each team.

| CAN OUR CHILDREN PLAY IN A TEAM WITH THEIR FRIENDS?

There will be the ability to play with friends and this will be coordinated closer to the season commencement.

We will do our best to fulfil requests, however, the final decision on what Clusters are formed is ultimately made by the Club. It will be the Head Coaches responsibility to determine who is in a team together on match days.

| WHEN IS TRAINING?

Pre-season training will commence in March on a Saturday morning. The Club will confirm the date when training commences once the clusters have been set and a head coach appointed.

Training once the season has commenced will be held on Saturday mornings, 30 mins prior to the match.

One of our NPL Junior Coaches Rob, will also be running an optional Junior Goals program on Wednesdays and/or Fridays. Term 1 will run from 31st January for 9 weeks. | WHAT DO WE WEAR ON TRAINING/MATCH DAYS?

All players will be issued a match day top to use for the season. The top is then handed back at the end of the season. A \$50 fee will be charged for any match day top that is returned in an unusable condition.

Blue shorts and blue socks will be required to be purchased to wear with the match day top. Our shorts are \$27.50ea and Socks are \$16ea.

All players will also need boots and shin pads to wear on match days and at training. We recommend Onside Sports in Malaga for boots and accessories as they have a large range of brands and sizes.

- Individual medallion
- Team photo
- Trophy presentation day
- Contribution towards football equipment (e.g. goals, cones, balls, bibs, etc.)
- Line marking
- One standard FAFC Club membership per registered child for one parent – entitles families to discounted venue hire and other member benefits including voting rights at the AGM. Once your player registration has been received and approved you will receive details on how to redeem your FAFC Club membership.
- FREE family entry to all Floreat Athena FC Senior NPL home matches

| HOW DO WE REGISTER?

Registrations are open! You can access Play Football to complete your registration [HERE](#).

You will be able to select from the following two options:

1. If you registered last year you can sign in using the same email you used to create the account.
2. If you have previously registered prior to 2019 you will need to set-up a new account or if you are registering on behalf of someone else, you must still create a Play Football account using your details. Once your account is created, you will be able to add details of the registrant.

Payment of our Club fees which includes the Football West and Football Australia fees are payable either online by credit/debit card or via bank deposit.



TIP If it is your first time creating an account with Play Football you will need a clear headshot of the child that you are registering!
