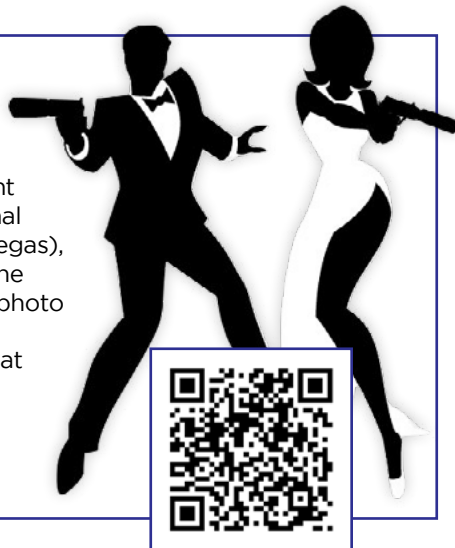

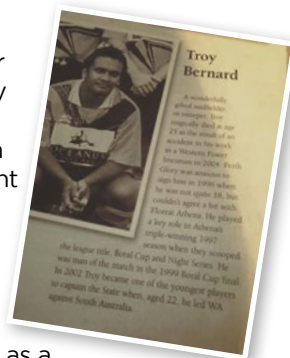

DID YOU KNOW...

Why do the Athena First team not have a player with a No 7 Strip?

Troy Bernard (1997 -2004) was a popular and well regarded member of the Athena playing family. Mentored by coach Jim Pyrgolios in the club's treble winning season of 1997, Troy quickly established himself as a solid central defender or central defensive midfielder. He was man of the match in the 1999 Boral Cup Final and was one of the youngest players to captain the state, when at aged 22 he led Western Australia against South Australia.

Tragedy struck for the Bernard family in 2004 when Troy died during a workplace accident while working as a Western Power linesman. His number 7 jersey for Athena has since been retired as a tribute to the Bernard family and the club continues to honour his memory by naming the young player of the year award after Troy.
